Two principles of training

Keep these two good principles in mind:

1. The behavior you “reward” with attention is the behavior which will continue
2. Your baby requires a certain amount of attention each day. If you give it to her when she is being “good,” then she will be good more often. And later, when she is older, she will not need to be “bad” in order to get your attention.
